Minimum water pressure required for the toilet to function is 0.08MPA. If the water pressure is below 0.08MPA, the toilet will not function as intended. Maximum water pressure this toilet can be used with is 0.75MPA.





Install your unit using the following steps


1 Open the box right side up

Remove the accessories first, then remove the unit from the top, as shown in the diagrams below.




2 Mark your drainage hole with a cross


1.place the installation template on the ground while being sure to properly align the drain hole.




2.Mark eight mounting holes on the ground with a pencil.Also outline the template edge to mark toilet placement later on.




3.Remove the installation template and drill eight holes at the marked positions.



4.Apply an even ring of sealant around the drain opening. Then, place the flange over the drain hole and bolt to the ground.




5.Place mounting brackets on the drain hole.




4 Install the ceramic toilet body, water supply hose and water filter


1.Place the wax ring on the drain hole at the bottom of the toilet body.




2. Align the drain hole on the toilet body with the drain hole on the ground, press down firmly to ensure the wax ring is fully in contact with the ground to form a seal.




3. First, secure both sides of the ceramic toilet body using two bolts, then install the cap.




4. Attach the flush water hose to the T-valve and tighten.



5. Attach the clean water hose to the T-valve and tighten.



6. Connect the T-valve to the water supply and tighten. Use gasket to prevent water leakage.




7. Finish installation.

5 Installing the remote

- 1. Using the remote holder as a guide, drill two 6mm(0.24 inches) diameter holes on the wall (bout 1.77 inches deep)
- 2. Knock an anchor into each drilled hole with a hammer.
- 3. Secure the remote holder with anchors
- 4.Use the screws to secure the holder to the wall,
- 5. On the remote controller, remove the rear battery cover to install batteries, then reinsert cover.
- 6.Once finished, remote is ready to be placed in its holder.

Detailed steps shown in the diagram below:

- XPlease use proper mounting tools for special wall surfaces(such as wood, HDF, etc.)
- *The remote control holder should be installed away from the bidet's spray trajectory.
- *The remote control holder should be installed within reach when seated on unit.
- XMake sure there is nothing to block the transmission between the toilet and its remote.



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


Connecting power


1. Open the water supply angle valve to maximum as shown in the figure.



2. Confirm that there are no water leaks at any of the connecting parts.

If water leaks, turn off water supply and unfasten the nuts. Reinstall all connections securely.





- (1). Check to see if the power is on.
- (2). Press the side power button, confirm the toilet is power on.

Testing the product

(Test whether the functions of the buttons on the remote controller and the rotating dial on the side of the toilet body work correctly.)


• Are all the functions working properly?

Rear Wash, Front Wash (Including water pressure & nozzle position adjustment), Heated Dryer, Water & Seat temperature Adjustment, Nozzle cleaning, Remote control. All functions listed above should be tested.

Checking Washing Nozzles

Please use your hand to hold the seat sensor area, turn the knob forward or press the "Rear" button on the remote controller, and use your hand to cover the front of the nozzle to block the flow of wash water to avoid spraying water on your body or clothing.

(Follow these same steps for the front nozzle)




Connecting your remote control

The toilet unit is paired to the remote control before it leaves the factory. If the remote control becomes disconnected, please reconnect using the following instructions.

1. Unplug the product from the power socket. Press and hold the Stop button for a few seconds, until the lights on the remote control start to flicker.

Press the stop button Remote for few seconds




2. Bring the remote control close to the toilet unit, then insert power plug into the power socket.



3. The remote lights stop flickering, and remain lit (in red).

Remote lights remain lighted (in red)




4. The remote control and toilet unit are now reconnected.

■ Power/Stop

In Standby mode: Press and hold for 3s to turn on the unit.

When turned on: If using rear wash, front wash or drying mode, a short button press will stop the wash/dryer. Pressing and holding the button for 3s will shut down the unit.



Front

Standby mode for front wash when seated

Rotate dial backwards 45 ° to start the front wash cycle.

Default setting: oscillating front wash. Operation cycle: front wash for 1.5 minutes + drying for 4 minutes + one flush. During front washing, turn the knob to adjust water pressure.

During drying, turn the knob to adjust the wind speed.

Rear

Standby mode for rear wash when seated

Rotate dial forwards 45 ° to start the rear wash cycle.

Default setting: oscillating rear wash. Operation cycle: rear wash for 1.5 minutes + drying for 4 minutes + one flush.

During rear washing, turn the knob to adjust water pressure.

During drying, turn the knob to adjust the wind speed.

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■ Auto flush

When the seat sensor no longer detects a user, it will automatically flush.

The toilet will only flush once.

■ Kick flush

Tap the "Kick Button" gently with your foot for easy manual flushing.

During flushing, the function of "Rear wash" "Front wash" cannot be used.

■ Kick controlled seat/lid

Tap the "Kick Button" gently with your foot to raise your toilet seat/lid.

Tap the kick button once: Lid opens
Tap the kick button twice: Seat raises
Tap the kick button three times: Seat and
Lid will close and toilet will flush.

Rear/front wash is not available during flushing.

■ UV Sterilization

Sterilization at the nozzle.


10s after the user leaves the seat, UV sterilization starts automatically, and lasts for 3 minutes. During this time, either press the "stop" button or activate the seat sensor to stop sterilization.





The deodorization feature activates automatically while the seat is occupied. Deodorization stops 3 minutes after the user leaves the seat.

Soft-closing lid/seat

Extends the life of the product by letting you close the toilet lid/seat silently.

Memory mode

On / Off: unit restores to last "memory" settings after normal Off / On.

Note, When restarting after a power failure: The unit settings will restore to the default mid range for water temp, water pressure, seat temp and nozzle position. Night light defaults to "On" upon restart."



Maintenance

To keep this product working smoothly, regular maintenance is required.

Note

- Turn off all power and water supply to the unit before starting any maintenance.
- Do not directly wash the product with water. It is prohibited.


■ Maintenance during Winter Season

To prevent freeze damage during winter conditions, measures must be taken to remove water from the unit if it will be stored or unused for long periods.

Note

- Before connecting the product to the water supply and electrical outlet, allow it to defrost for 30 mins in a warm indoor environment.
- In cases of extreme cold/freezing/the nozzle is frozen in place, wrap the water supply line with a warm towel. Never pour hot water into or on the toilet, and never use a hot dryer directly on the product.

Maintenance of the nozzle



When the seat is not occupied, press the "Nozzle Clean" button on the remote control. The nozzle will extend. Proceed to clean the exposed nozzle with a soft bristled toothbrush.

Do not forcefully hold the nozzle, otherwise it may break.

Please change the nozzle spout if it is blocked.
